Cathy Drumm clinic on May 6-7, 2011

“Ride-Critique-Show” Open Schooling Horse Show on May 8th.

Schooling horse show consists of riding the class once, receiving a critique from Cathy and re-riding the same class which will then be pinned. This will be a great way to get feedback from a judge and prepare for the show season.

Cathy Drumm has been an equestrian instructor and trainer for over 25 years. Raised and educated in England, she learned to ride in the classic school of horsemanship. She competed extensively as a member of a Pony Club team, passing her "B" test at the age of 14. She also competed as an individual in dressage and eventing. Upon graduating from college with a certificate to teach high school English she moved to the United States in 1979.

After teaching high school for 3 years she decided to resume her equestrian career and began providing instruction at several local farms. It was not long before she owned her own farm. At Golden Hill Farm in Lenox, MA she established a highly successful business which included lessons, college classes, school vacation programs and a rigorous show schedule both locally and nationally.

Cathy's straightforward, patient, and yet determined style of teaching attracts students of all levels from near and far. Cathy has the ability to explain to the student and the horse how to proceed on the simplest step by step path towards their goal, whatever that may be. She has experience training horses and their riders towards excellence in most disciplines ranging from cross country and trail riding to Dressage and Hunter/Jumpers.

Her students have had great successes in whatever their chosen discipline. These have ranged from helping owners to achieve daily training goals to coaching students to top placings at National Hunter/Jumper Finals including Harrisburg, Syracuse, Pony Finals and USET finals in Gladstone. Stalls are available for the day (\$10) and/or overnight (\$20).

The following are the levels available. Riders will be grouped (4-6) according to skill levels. There are a limited number of private lessons available on Friday afternoon/early evening.

Walk/trot to cross rails:

Cathy believes that the way we start our beginners is as important as anything else we teach. Through the use of fun exercises and a clear, unique way of explaining things, she will ensure that these riders finish up with increased confidence and a better understanding of the basics of riding.

Jumping 2' to 3'; (sessions will be based on riders with common abilities, i.e. 2-2'3", 2'6"-2'9" -3')

As riders become more proficient, they need to have a deeper understanding of how their body movements affect the horse. This lesson will focus on balance, control, and the ability to adjust the horse's or pony's stride.

Moving up to 3'6":

Flatwork, flatwork, flatwork! As the jumps get bigger, the rider's understanding of the importance of flatwork becomes essential. This lesson will incorporate fun, interesting, and more advanced flat exercises that will then be applied to jumping the bigger jumps.

Training your horse or pony to jump; (Private only)

Whether you are starting from scratch with a youngster, retraining an older horse, or dealing with a problem animal, this lesson will help. Cathy has many years and hundreds of horses worth of experience to draw from. She will assess every individual's situation and be able to develop a course of training that will address each issue and enable the horse to progress in a happy, non-stressful manner.

Concessions will be available on Saturday and Sunday.

Liability Waiver and Hold Harmless Agreement

UNDER MISSOURI LAW, AN EQUINE PROFESSIONAL IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO OR DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN EQUINE ACTIVITIES RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISK OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES PURSUANT TO THE REVISED STATUTES OF MISSOURI.

Witness this agreement on this _____ day of _____ of 20____, by and among HERITAGE LIVESTOCK, LLC , DENNIS AND MARIELLEN RAUCHER and _____(Rider). For consideration received, and in return for the use, day and on all future dates of the property, facilities and services of HERITAGE LIVESTOCK, DENNIS AND MARIELLEN RAUCHER, Rider, his or her heirs, assigns, and representatives hereby agrees as follows:

1. **INHERENT RISKS AND ASSUMPTION OF RISKS.** Rider acknowledges the inherent risks of accidents and injuries to person and property in all horse-related activities and hereby expressly assumes all risks associated with participating in such activities. The inherent risks include, but are not limited to, the propensity of equine to behave in unpredictable ways such as running, bucking, biting, kicking, shying, stumbling, rearing, falling or stepping on, that may result in an injury, harm or death to persons on or around them; the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals; certain hazards such as surface and sub surface conditions; collisions with other animals; the limited availability of emergency medical care; and the potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to control over the animal or not acting within such participant's ability. Rider assumes all risk in connection with participation in any and all horse related activities for Rider and any family member or other person accompanying Rider, and expressly waives any claims for an injury or loss arising there from. Rider agrees to abide by and follow HERITAGE LIVESTOCK, LLC/DENNIS & MARIELLEN RAUCHER rules and regulations, which are available upon request. Rider further acknowledges that the behavior of any animal is contingent to some extent upon the ability of Rider. Fair disclosure of Rider's abilities has been made to HERITAGE LIVESTOCK, LLC/DENNIS & MARIELLEN RAUCHER.
2. **DISCLOSURE OF ABILITIES.** Rider has made full and fair disclosure to Rider's abilities and other information that may be on Rider's ability to engage in any horse related activities.
3. **INDEMNIFICATION, RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS.** Rider agrees to indemnify, hold harmless to defend HERITAGE LIVESTOCK, LLC/DENNIS & MARIELLEN RAUCHER and any of their members, managers, owners, officers, employees and/or agents from and against, any and all claims, demands, causes of action, damages, judgment, orders, costs or expenses, including attorney's fees, known or unknown which may in any way arise from or be in any way connected with Rider's use of or services the property or equines of HERITAGE LIVESTOCK, LLC/DENNIS & MARIELLEN RAUCHER, including but not limited to, loss or damage of any equipment or personal property, personal or body injury or death, or illness to Rider, to any horse owned by Rider, and to any family member or other person accompanying Rider on the premises of HERITAGE LIVESTOCK, LLC (11196 Lawrence 1165, Mount Vernon, MO) and or participating in any equine activities sponsored by and/or related to HERITAGE LIVESTOCK/DENNIS & MARIELLEN RAUCHER
4. **WAIVER.** Rider agrees to waive the protection of any applicable statutes in this jurisdiction whose purpose, substance and/or effect is to provide that a general release shall not extend to claims, material or otherwise, which the person giving the release does not know or suspect to exist at all time of executing said release.
